## Dates & Deadlines

**January 1** - New Year's Day

**January 2** - New Year's Day Observed (County offices are closed)

**January 16** - Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday (County offices are closed)

**January 22** - 2023 Lunar New Year

**February 15** - Last Day to File Affidavit for Commercial Fishing, Historical Aircraft Exemption, Religious Exemption, Welfare Exemption, and last day to file affidavit for Classification of Documented Vessel.

Last day to file homeowners' exemption for full amount of exemption. You can still apply for this exemption after the deadline for a partial exemption.

Deadline for racehorse owners to pay Annual Racehorse Tax without penalties.

Last day to file possessory interest real property usage report with County Assessor in lieu of Preliminary Change of Ownership Report or Change of Ownership Statement.

**\*NOTE:** To receive the full welfare exemption, the claim must be filed by February 15th, or within 30 days of the date of Notice of Supplemental Assessment, whichever comes first. However, a partial exemption may be available for some claims even when filed after the deadline.

## Resource

### California Winter Storms 2022-2023

The California Winter Storms of 2022-2023 have been declared a State of Emergency. Property owners impacted by the Winter Storms in 2022 and 2023 may be eligible for calamity property tax relief. This relief may include a temporary reduction in assessed values as well as an exclusion from reassessment when the property is repaired or rebuilt. To be eligible, your property must have suffered at least \$10,000 in physical

damage to taxable property. Damage to personal belongings such as household furnishings, are not eligible as they are not assessed for property tax purposes.

To qualify for property tax relief, you must file a calamity claim with the Assessor's Office within twelve (12) months from the date the property was damaged or destroyed. In addition, the loss must exceed \$10,000.

**Filing deadlines:**

**Calamity:** Submit a calamity application to the Assessor's Office within 12 months of the date of damage. Applications received after that date are not eligible for calamity relief (reduction in assessed value and exclusion from reassessment upon repair/rebuilding).

## **Façade and Tenant Improvement Program (FTIP) Grants**


If you are a business owner or a commercial property owner in the City of Oakland, the Façade and Tenant Improvement Programs (FTIP) can help you enhance the appearance of your commercial building to reduce blight and encourage economic development. Grants are used for approved exterior and interior renovations to commercial and mixed-use properties.

### **Grant funding**

- Façade (exterior improvement) grants: Applicants can be reimbursed for a percentage of the cost of eligible exterior improvements to building facades, up to a maximum of \$30,000.
- Façade *grant caps follow a sliding scale, determined by the property's linear length.*
- Tenant Improvement (interior improvements or TI) grants: Applicants can be reimbursed for a percentage of the cost of eligible interior improvements (TIs) in commercial properties/units, up to a maximum of \$45,000.

The first Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) will be issued with an application period of December 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023. Applications received during the NOFA will be prioritized based on equity scoring criteria. If you would like to be notified when the application period opens, please [complete this form](#).

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Gay, bisexual, and other men or trans-persons who have sex with men
- Sex workers of any sexual orientation or gender identity
- Persons who have had close contact with someone with suspected/confirmed MPX within the past 14 days
- Persons who had close contact with others at an event or social gathering where a suspected/confirmed MPX case was identified within the past 14 days
- Laboratory workers who routinely perform MPX virus testing
- Clinicians who have had a high-risk occupational exposure (e.g., examined MPX lesions or collected MPX specimens without using recommended personal protective equipment)

## Vaccine Distribution

All Alameda County residents, ages 5 and older, are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine in Alameda County.

- Pfizer is approved for all individuals, ages 5 and older.

- Johnson & Johnson and Moderna are approved for all individuals, ages 18 and older.

### **Booster / Additional Dose Information**

Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson are available as boosters and as additional doses for eligible individuals.

For those individuals who first received a Johnson & Johnson vaccination, a booster shot is recommended by the CDC after 2 months. Here are the current CDC recommendations:

For the first booster, an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna) is preferred in most situations. The second booster must be an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine.

Booster shots are recommended to help restore protection and provide further protection from newer variants of the virus.
